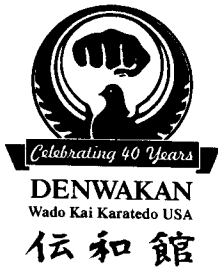

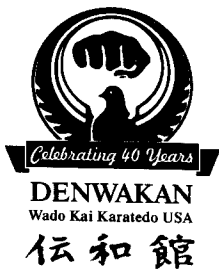

## Tournament Rules & Criteria

### KATA (All Divisions)

- Point system to determine winners.
- May perform any traditional Japanese or Okinawan kata.
- Tie breaker kata for Intermediate and Advanced divisions must be different kata.

### KUMITE – WKF Rules of Competition with following modifications:

- **Children Divisions:** 1 ½ minutes, stop time, 8 points ceiling (first to attain 8 pts wins). All techniques to the face, head and neck must have absolute control. Points will not be awarded for techniques that touch.
- **Boys (13 – 17) & Girls (14 – 17):** 2 minutes, stop time, 8 points ceiling (first to attain 8 pts wins). All hand techniques to face, head, and neck must have absolute control. No points awarded if targets touched. Kicks to head, face and neck allowed to make non-injurious, light, controlled touch.
- **Adult Divisions (except Division S 28):** 2 minutes, stop time, 8 points ceiling (first to attain 8 pts wins). **Division S 28:** 3 minutes. All techniques allowed to make non-injurious, light, controlled “skin touch” to face, head and neck.

### MANDATORY EQUIPMENT

- White karate gi, cloth/soft-leather fist guards (white or WKF red/blue), mouth guard, groin protection (males).

### OPTIONAL EQUIPMENT

- White head gear (juniors), shin guards, chest protectors (females).
